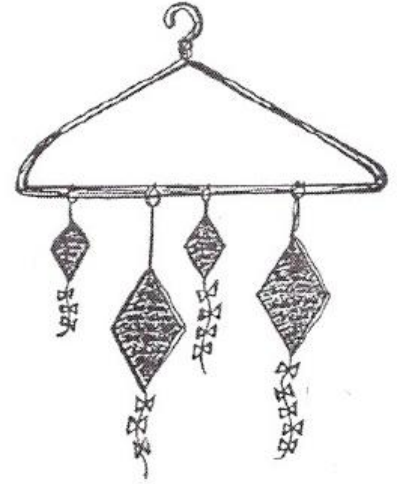
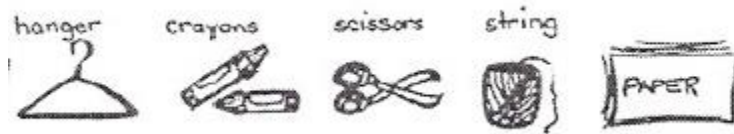

1. Think about a shape that goes along with your required reading book.
2. Draw and cut out 4 shapes and provide the information below on each:

Shape 1: Title of book, author's name, and your name

Shape 2: Describe the main character with three descriptive words and a draw a small picture.

Shape 3: Tell what happened in the story (at least 1 complete sentence).

Shape 4: Explain why you liked or didn't like the book (at least 1 complete sentence).

3. Decorate your shapes with crayon and attach to the hanger with string. Please make sure information can still be read.
